❖ **HOW TO APPLY:**

The prospectus along with application forms (for registration) is available in the college office on remittance of Rs. 1500 which will be non refundable.

❖ **CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION PROCESS:**

1. B.SC NURSING (8 SEMESTER i.e. 4 YEARS DEGREE PROGRAMME):

For B.Sc. Nursing course candidate has to be appeared in the Entrance Test conducted by The Atal Medical & Research University, HP. Website: www.amruhp.ac.in

Eligibility for Admission to the B. Sc Nursing Undergraduate Degree Course:-

- i. Female Children of Bonafide Himachali/Domicile/Himachal Govt. employees and employees of Autonomous bodies wholly or partially financed by the Himachal Pradesh Government will only be eligible to apply for admission to 4 years B.Sc. Nursing Degree Course through Entrance Test to be conducted by Atal Medical & Research University- NerChowk, Mandi, HP
- ii. For filling up of 50% Management Quota Seats in Private un-aided B.Sc. Nursing Colleges in State of Himachal Pradesh, there will be no domicile requirement.
- iii. The entry age of candidates should be 17 years as on 31st December, of the admission session and there is no upper age limit. The candidates will ensure that they must fulfill the above condition. Age as recorded in the matriculation certificate will be entertained.
- iv. Admission to married candidates will be allowed subject to production of medical fitness certificate.
- v. A candidate should have passed 10+2 or its equivalent examination from H.P. Board of School Education/AISSCE/CBSE/ICSE/SSCE/HSCE or any other Board/University established by law in India in the subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology and English individually and with 45% marks taken together in Physics, Chemistry and Biology at the qualifying examination. The candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC, the marks obtained in Physics, Chemistry and Biology taken together in qualifying examination will be 40% instead of 45% as stated above. Provided further that English is a compulsory subject in 10+2 for being eligible for admission to B.Sc (Nursing) course. The candidate should be medically fit.

Note:

- I. The candidates who have passed their 10+2 examination from National Institute of Open School or appeared in 10+2 examination Science (Medical) conducted by National Institute of Open School can also apply to this test.
- II. The above qualifications will only determine the eligibility of a candidate for admission, but the actual basis of admission shall be on the basis of marks obtained by the candidates in the Entrance Test.

Physical Fitness

Besides fulfilling the eligibility conditions, the candidate should be certified by Govt. Medical officer/Registered Medical Practitioner as physically and mentally fit to pursue the course.

❖ CRITERIA FOR ADMISSION PROCESS

• GNM NURSING (3 YEAR DIPLOMA COURSE)

No entrance exam is required. Candidate can directly get admission to GNM course. Candidate can directly get the prospectus from college and fill the application form.

- i. 10+2 with 40% marks from any recognized board.
- ii. Candidates are also eligible from State Open School recognized by State Government and
- iii. National Institute of Open School (NIOS) recognized by Central Government.
- iv. Age-Minimum entry age for admission will be 17years. (As on31stDecember of that year) and there is no upper age limit. The candidates will ensure that they must fulfill the above condition. Age as recorded in the matriculation certificate will be entertained.

4. Hostels

- Hostel accommodation is available for all the students. There is also separate Residential Quarters for teaching faculty and other staff in hostel.
- Each Hostel has a dining hall with adequate seating capacity for students. Students are under the disciplinary supervision of the Chief Warden and Assistant Wardens and Hostel Supervisor. Staying in Hostel & taking food from the hostel mess is compulsory for all students.
- Transportation: College buses are available to take the students to various affiliated hospitals for clinical experience and community health nursing in rural and urban areas.
- Each student has to follow and abide by the rules and regulations of the hostel/college as intimated upon joining the hostel/college



5. Other Facilities

Clinical training at renowned hospitals, Government/Private Hospitals, other out-state

Hospitals and community health centres etc.

Uniform and books are arranged by the institute at own cost borne by the students. However students will purchase notebooks and stationary on their own.

Educational tours and picnic are arranged for students.

Student guidance and counseling/placement services are available.

The Management provides recreational facilities like news paper, magazine, indoor and outdoor games, and other facilities like telephone, first aids kit and doctor on call.

Every year job placements given by the institute to each pass out students.

❖ **COLLEGE RULES AND REGULATIONS**

1. Students are expected to maintain high standards of conduct and ethics
2. Use of indecent language or behavior is forbidden student should be respectful to faculty and staff.
3. Student must wear college uniform. Students are required to wear their ID cards in college timing.
4. Students should reach college on time otherwise strict action will be taken.
5. Pay your college dues as per the prescribed schedule (dates fixed by the college) & notified time to time by the college. Delay in payment beyond due dates will be fined accordingly and consider with late fees only (Minimum Rs 50/day).
6. The fee/fine and other dues once paid are Not Refundable.
7. If the applicant leaves the college before completion of the course, no fee would be refundable and students has to pay full amount of the course duration fee along with hostel rent, transport as well as other college fees etc.
8. In case of any breakage of equipment, material either in Hospital, Hostel, Demonstration room, Laboratories etc. concerned students has to bear the cost of the breakage.
9. The management, administration of the college has the right to change the fee structure the college fee/funds at any time if required & we shall abide by the changed structure.
10. During the entire course of training period, the applicant will not marry, and if already Married will not conceive/get pregnant.
11. No mobile phones are allowed in the college.
12. The applicant will not get involved in any kind RAGGING ACTIVITIES if involved will be punished as per the guidelines and laws of state and Central Government, which may mean rustication from the college.
13. Leaves are to be sanctioned in urgent situations i.e. Regarding death, any serious illness Other leaves will be sanctioned only if student have 90% attendance in theory and any correspondence from parent's side is done.
14. No leave will be sanctioned during clinical posting as 100% attendance is compulsory as per INC. In case of absence during the time Rs 500 fine will be applicable and also will do compensation.
15. In case of absence from college without any information or without any sanctioned leave will pay Rs 200 fine per day.
16. Leave will be considered only if it will be taken with proper channel. No whatsapp messages on groups will be considered.
17. Medical to be submitted by the students in case of medical leave. Without medical certificate student will pay fine Rs 150/day.

18. All the students have to be deposit the imposed fine within stipulated time period of two days. Otherwise strict action will taken as decided by college.
19. DMC's, Course Completion & Relieving Certificate of the students will be issued only after the clearance certificate of all the college/hostel/transportation funds/fine paid by the student for the entire course duration. Students must keep their all the fees paid record ready in case of any conflicts.

❖ RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR GIRL'S HOSTEL

The following rules shall apply to FEMALE students residing in the nursing hostels of Violation of any rule will make the inmate liable to disciplinary action including expulsion from the hostels and also from institution:-

1. Every student must remember that the hostel is the home of the student on the campus and therefore, she should behave herself on the campus as well as outside in such a manner as to bring credit to her and to the institution.
2. student once admitted in the hostel will continue to be a hostel inmate throughout the course unless otherwise debarred from the hostel on disciplinary grounds. Unless they clear the dues, they shall not be allowed to take university examinations. further, she may be expelled from the halls of residence and/or messes.
3. All the student are instructed to use cell phone during mentioned hours as prescribed by the college authority time to time. if any student found using phone other than mentioned time, their phones will be taken by the authorities and also will be fined Rs. 100/- minimum.
4. Hostel inmates are requested to maintain their surroundings neat and clean.
5. It is mandatory for students residing in the Hostel to join the mess attached to the hostel. Hostellers are required to dine in the dining hall. No hosteller is permitted to take food in the room except for those reported sick with prior permission of hostel warden. Indoor cooking including making of tea/coffee/noodles in the rooms is strictly prohibited. The hostellers shall not waste food, electricity & water. Wastage of food is national loss.
6. Every student residing in the hostel must dine in the hostel messes only. Individual/group cooking in the rooms is forbidden. If found, they will be expelled from hostel or fined. Cooking in hostel rooms is not permitted. All instructions/notices displayed on notice boards will be deemed to have been read by all residents and excuses for non-compliance of such instructions and notices will not be accepted. Residents are advised to look at the notice board every day to acquaint themselves with latest information/orders.
7. Hostel students shall not leave the headquarters without prior permission of the Warden/Chief Warden. They shall have to apply for permission in writing in advance stating the reason for leaving and the address of destination. Hostel students who leave hostel without the application and prior permission from the concerned authorities shall be deemed to be missing and their parent/guardian or even the police authorities may be intimated.
8. Accommodation in the hostel cannot be claimed as a matter of right. Students who disturb peace and violate the rules of the hostel on the campus will be expelled from the hostels.
9. Visitors are not permitted in the hostel after 6.00 p.m. However, in special cases, prior
10. Permission of warden must be obtained to stay beyond the allotted hours.
11. No parent or guardian of a student is permitted to stay in the hostel.
12. Any hostel student harboring any unauthorized person(s) will be expelled from the hostel immediately. Residents returning late to their Hostels will be fined. The HOIs and Parents of residents coming very late or who are habitual offenders will be informed. In acute cases the resident may have to vacate the Hostel
13. No association of students on the basis of region, caste or creed is permitted. No secret activities or meetings are permitted on the hostel premises. For holding any meeting in the

hostel room or anywhere in the hostel area, prior written permissions should be obtained from the principal

14. No resident of the hostel is permitted to take any article/utensils etc, outside the hostel Mess premise and even to his/her room. No one should use the belongings of other students without their consent.
15. The hostellers are neither allowed to keep private electrical equipment nor would tamper with electrical fittings provided in rooms. Unauthorized possession will lead to confiscation of the goods. Each student shall use only one tube-light not exceeding 40 watts. Use of all unauthorized electrical appliances such as heaters etc., is strictly prohibited and these will be confiscated, and the concerned student will be penalized. However, usage of computer and printer in the hostel room will be allowed with prior permission from the Chief Warden. Fans and lights must be switched off when the students leave their rooms. Light must be switched off positively when they go to bed. In case it is noticed that fans/lights are on the locked room, a heavy penalty will be imposed for wasting the costly energy sources. No televisions are permitted to be kept in the hostel rooms by the students. Students have to watch TV in the common TV room provided in the hostels.
16. The Chief Warden/ Warden or his representative may enter any room for verification at any time of the day or night. The room of any student in the hostel can be inspected at any time by the Warden/Chief Warden or any authorised member of the institute staff or district police officials. Inmates are advised to keep their ID cards with them and show them on demand.
17. The hostellers themselves are personally responsible to safeguard their belongings. They are advised not to keep large amounts of cash or valuables like gold ring, costly wristwatch etc., in their rooms. They should also take care of their Purse, Calculators, Cell Phones, Lap tops, and Books. In case of theft or loss of any item the hostel authorities/institute will not be responsible for such loss. The hostellers are advised to keep their boxes, suitcases, cupboards, etc., securely locked with good quality locks. They are advised to deposit extra cash in the bank or in the post office or at any other safe place. All residents must take care of their ATM/ Debit cards. They must not disclose their PIN to anybody- even to their best friends
18. The residents are forbidden to keep any heavy cash/ valuables in the room. The resident is responsible for the safety of his/her items inside the rooms. Giving the room keys to any person (except the Block Supervisors/Caretakers/Wardens) in good faith is at their own risk. The management will not take any responsibility for any loss of such costly articles /money. They may deposit all sums of money not immediately required by them for their expenses in the local Banks.
19. Keeping of lethal weapons like sticks, rods, chains etc. in the hostel rooms is strictly prohibited. The hostel cannot be considered as the hiding place for miscreants. The police authorities may enter the campus and detain any one depending upon the severity of the offence.
20. The consumption, storage or supply of liquor, smoking or any sort of intoxicant like chewing of tobacco etc., use of drugs and narcotics and even possession of such things are strictly prohibited and if found guilty, the offenders will be dealt with severely, including prosecution like rusticated from the institute.
21. Ragging in any form is banned inside and outside the campus. Strict action will be taken against the defaulters. No leniency will be shown to the offenders. Suspension and or withdrawal from the hostel/ college is one of the actions taken promptly. Ragging of any kind is severely punishable as per the HIMACHAL PRADESH State Prohibition of Ragging Act, 1997 and 2002.
22. Boarders will be personally and collectively responsible for any loss/damage to the properties and equipment and other fittings in the common halls. Students should not break open or try to break open the occupied/vacant rooms of the hostels.. In case of damage to any buildings, furniture, apparatus or other property of the college, the loss caused to the institutions shall be recovered directly from those identified persons whenever possible. But, if persons who

cause the damage are unknown, the cost of repairing it, as may be assessed by the hostel authorities, will be distributed equally among all the students of such groups or associations as may be found responsible.

❖ INSTRUCTIONS FOR STUDENTS

- Writing on the walls and sticking posters or pamphlets in the college/hostel campus is banned.
- Use of mobile phones is forbidden in classrooms, Principal's office, examination hall and library.
- Party based badges are not allowed in the college/hostel campus.
- Assignments, College Terminal Examination and 80% theory attendance/100% clinical attendance is compulsory for internal assessment.
- Absenting from a class for 10 consecutive days may render the student's name to be struck off.
- Outsider's entry in the college campus would be permissible with identity card only.
- Use of drugs in the college premises or even in the vicinity of the college is strictly prohibited.
- Students should come well dressed (in prescribed uniform) to the college.
- Good moral behaviour is expected from every student of the college.
- Ragging as well as indulging in any kind of anti-social activity is a criminal offence.
- Damaging of college/hostel property in any way is an offence.
- Students should co-operate with the authorities in maintaining cleanliness in and around the campus.

Note: The entire campus of the college is under surveillance of the CCTV cameras.
